SUBMISSION FORMAT REQUIREMENTS:

Abstracts are to be a minimum of two and a maximum of four paragraphs (approximately 500 words) on 1 to 2 double-spaced full pages of text (12-point, Times New Roman font), including bibliography. Additional pages of supporting tables and graphics may be included. Each page must contain a "footer" with the corresponding author's last name, abstract title, and page number (example: Smith, Regional Approach to XYZ, page 1 of 2).

Abstracts must clearly define the objectives, status, methodology, findings, and significance of the investigation, study, application, or installation review. Submissions on hot topics, regulatory issues, and new water or wastewater technologies and/or applications are especially welcome.

There is no limit to the number of abstracts that may be submitted by an individual, company, organization, or institution. Membership in IOA is not a requirement for presentation. The official language of the IOA-PAG technical programs is English.
